


In Memoriam Steve Zollinger

Steve Zollinger, a 1970 graduate of Fletcher was voted the senior most likely to succeed, and also had the distinction of being the valedictorian of his class. Shortly after his graduation it became necessary to remove both of his kidneys because of disease. A transplant operation was performed in which Steve's mother donated one of her kidneys. The Student Association, as well as the community, took on the project of raising funds for this expensive operation.

It was a high day at Fletcher when the entire student body was able to go to the airport to meet Steve and his mother on their return from Duke University Medical Center.

Steve had a very positive attitude about life and was willing to leave things in God's hands. He was certainly looking forward with hope to the time when sickness and pain would be forever obliterated. He died on Sabbath, July 14, 1973.


If it is true that the mind and mores of a school are formed by its leaders, then Mrs. Fern Anderson has certainly fulfilled her part.

With each of us you share these good qualities with a Christian attitude and a smile.




