

















DEDICATION





















CHAPLAIN'S MESSAGE

Barbara Wilson was driving not far from Ventura, California, one day when she accidentally put her foot on the accelerator instead of the brake. The car crashed through a guardrail and rolled 150 feet down a cliff. Fearing the car was going to catch fire, Mrs. Wilson crawled through a shattered rear window and rolled another 350 feet down the cliff herself. Miraculously she survived her accident and subsequent fall, but she was unable to move because of leg injuries. So she lay at the bottom of the cliff without food and water for two days and two nights.

At this time a man came walking by with his dog. Mrs. Wilson called out for help, and the man stopped and called down to ask what was wrong. When she told him that she had been hurt in a car accident, he told her he didn't want to become involved. "Besides," he said as he moved on, "any dame who is fool enough to drive on Highway 33 alone deserves all she gets." With that he was gone.


Four days after her ordeal began, Mrs. Wilson's cries for help were heard by two teenage boys who happened along. She was rescued and treated for dehydration and cuts on her leg in the Ventura Hospital, and went on to make a successful recovery.


































































Pastor's Message

GOD WANTS YOU TO BE A WINNER

"I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me . . .

Phillippians 3:20 (NIV)

God doesn't make losers, and He doesn't call people out of darkness and away from sin to become losers. God makes winners out of losers, and above everything else, He wants you to be a winner. The apostle Paul was convinced of this truth when he wrote of himself, "I can do everything through him who gives me strength" (Phillippians 4:13, NIV). The secret of being a winner is revealed in this text. It is trusting in Christ, believing that in Christ you have access to all the resources - knowledge, skills, equipment, etc. - that you need in order to become a winner. Being a winner is not simply the result of thinking positively about yourself or about others or about the world as a whole, since for many that would be an exercise in self-deception. But God's winners are not negative thinkers either. They are men and women of faith, hope, and love; men and women of courage and conviction who are informed about the forces of evil and destruction at work in the world, but are not frightened by them. Their courage and conviction arise from their belief in God. Through faith in Christ they move from one victory to another in God's great cause, and become champions of justice and freedom. The world today stands in great need of such men and women, for without them it would be swallowed up in despair and ruin. That is why God is calling you to serve Him, to become the salt of the earth, the light of the world. He wants you to be a winner and then to tell others about what He has enabled you to do. If you have not responded to His call, you still have time. Why not become a winner now. We need you on the team!

PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Dear Students.

Have you ever asked yourself, "What is Christian education?" Some may say that Christian education means going to a school where one has morning devotions, prayer, and the study of the Bible along with the other subjects taught. Others may quote from the book, **Education**, that it is "the harmonious development of the physical, the mental, and the spiritual powers." p.13. And yet others say, and rightly so, that it means the restoration of man to the image of God. These, certainly, are good definitions and are worthy goals to which each person should strive. But I challenge each student's thinking to a more practical application of this term "Christian education". When one really stops to think, one realizes that it simply means to follow Christ's example and to be like Him in our everyday life. It is then that we can truly call ourselves Christians.

I would like to share with you some thought-provoking statements about the childhood of Christ that I gleaned from the book, **Desire of Ages.** They are as follows:

"As a child Jesus manifested a peculiar loveliness of disposition. His willing hands were ever ready to serve others. He manifested a patience that nothing could disturb, and truthfulness that would never sacrifice integrity. In principle, firm as a rock, His life revealed the grace of unselfish courtesy." pp. 68,69.

"From His earliest years He was possessed of one purpose; He lived to bless others." p.70.


"He was . . . a loving obedient son."p.72.
