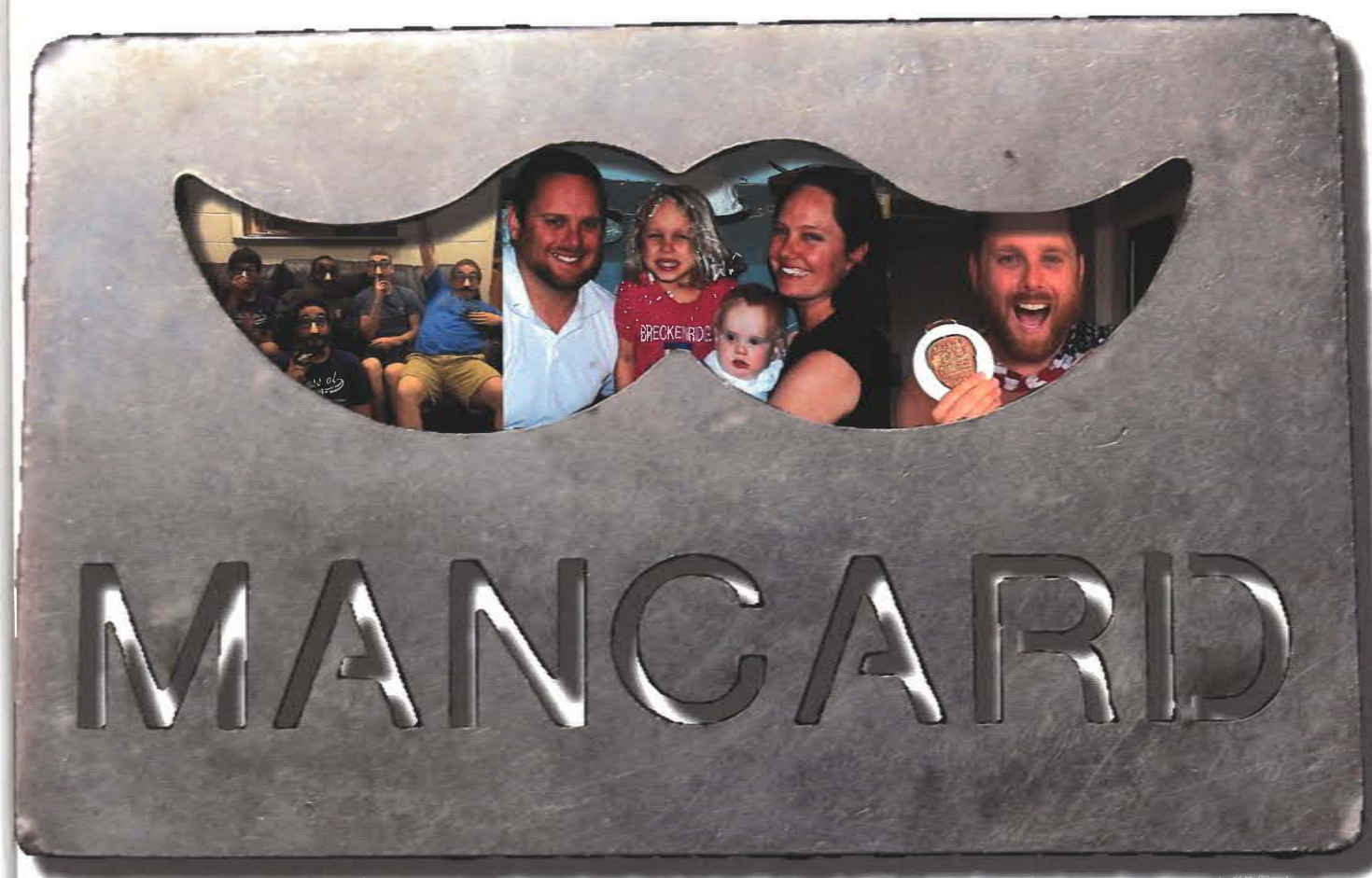

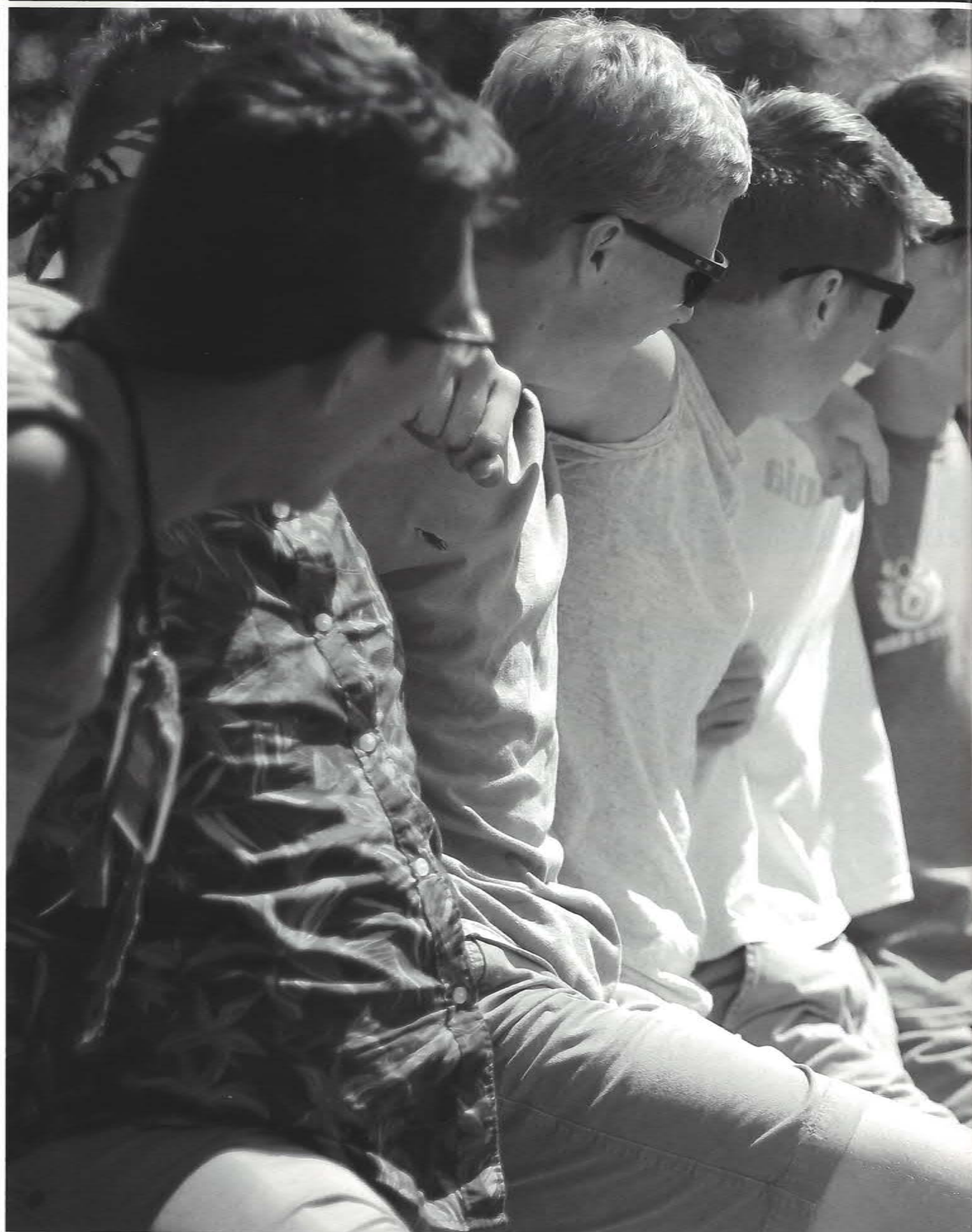


S P A R K

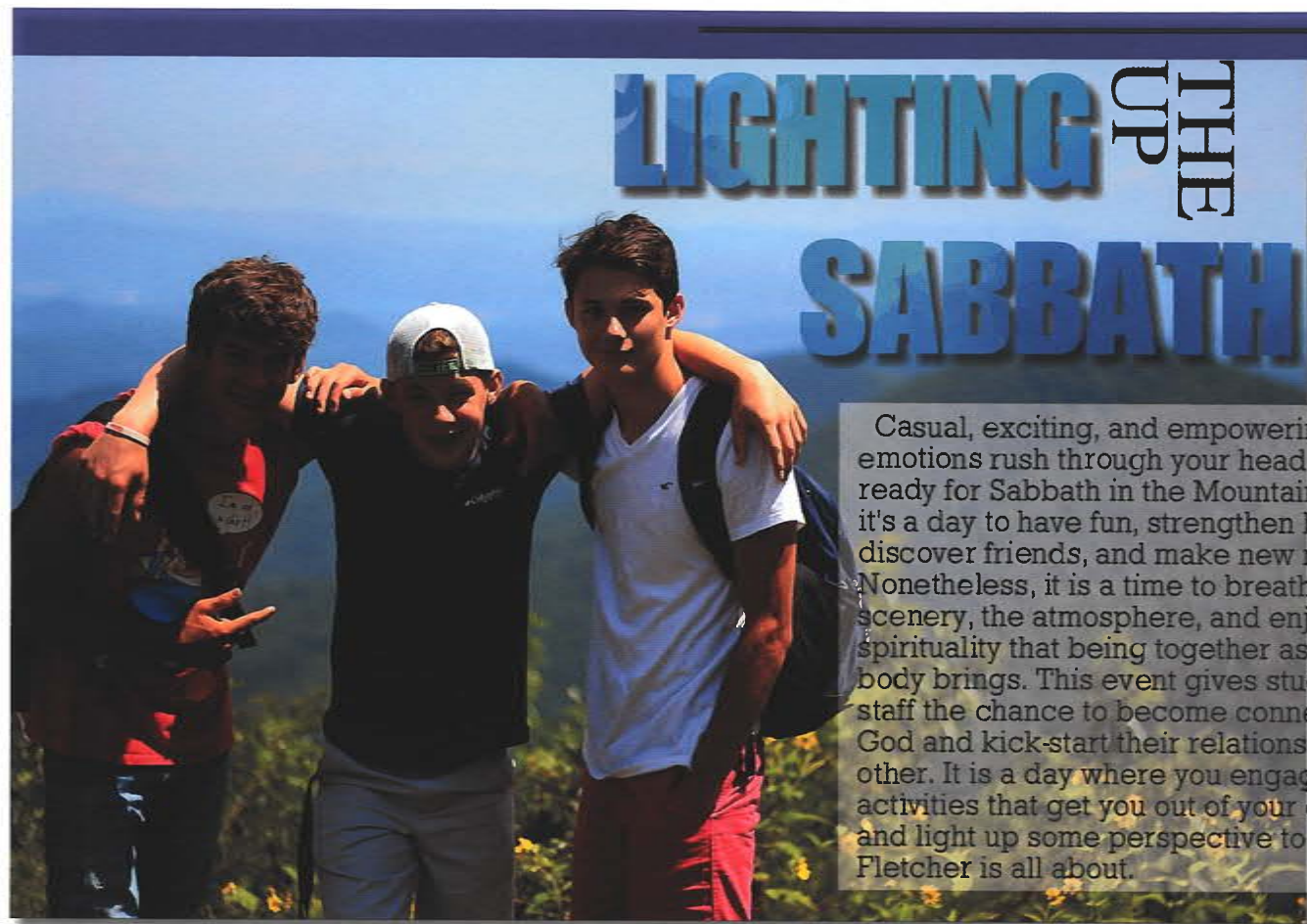

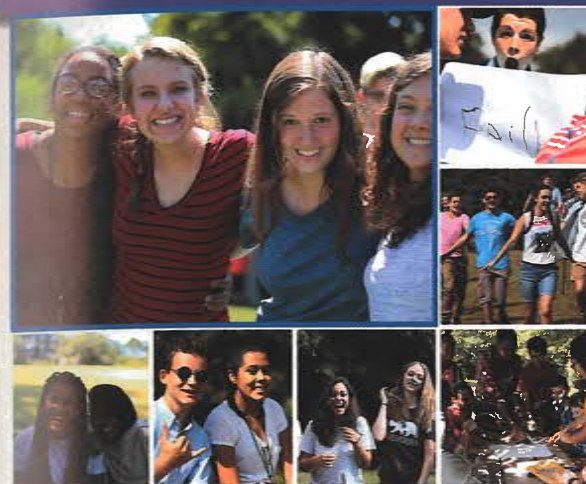

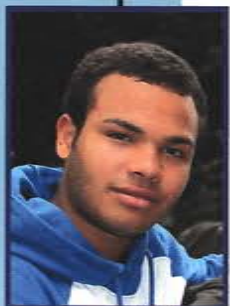

The cheerleaders are probably the most important people you see. When running, jumping, or playing football, you have to have something motivating you.

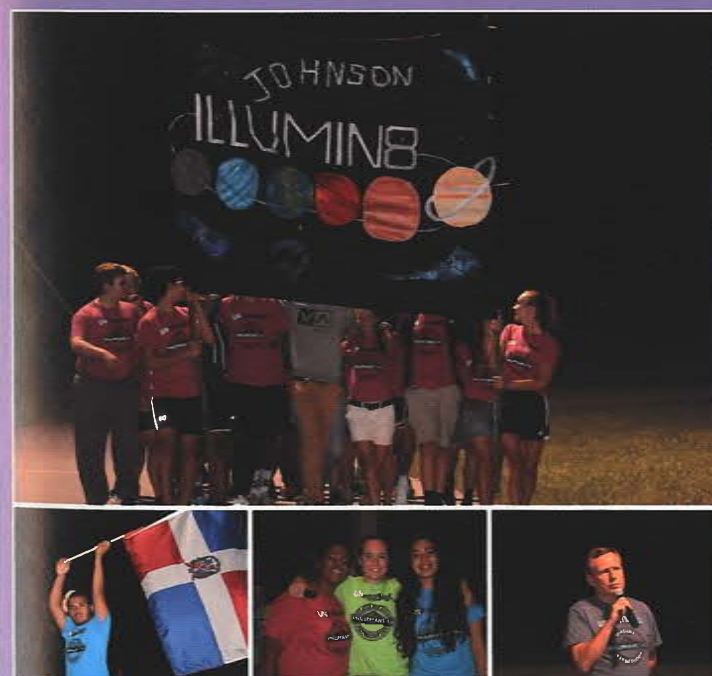

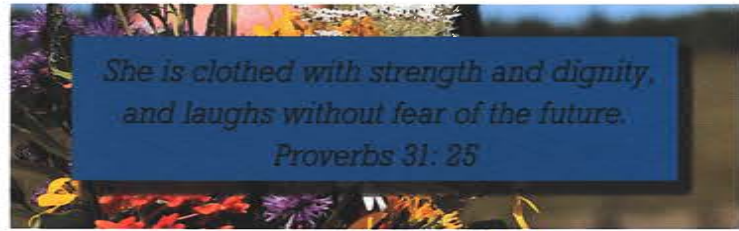

Fall Picnic is not just some ordinary event, it is truly what brings us together as a family.



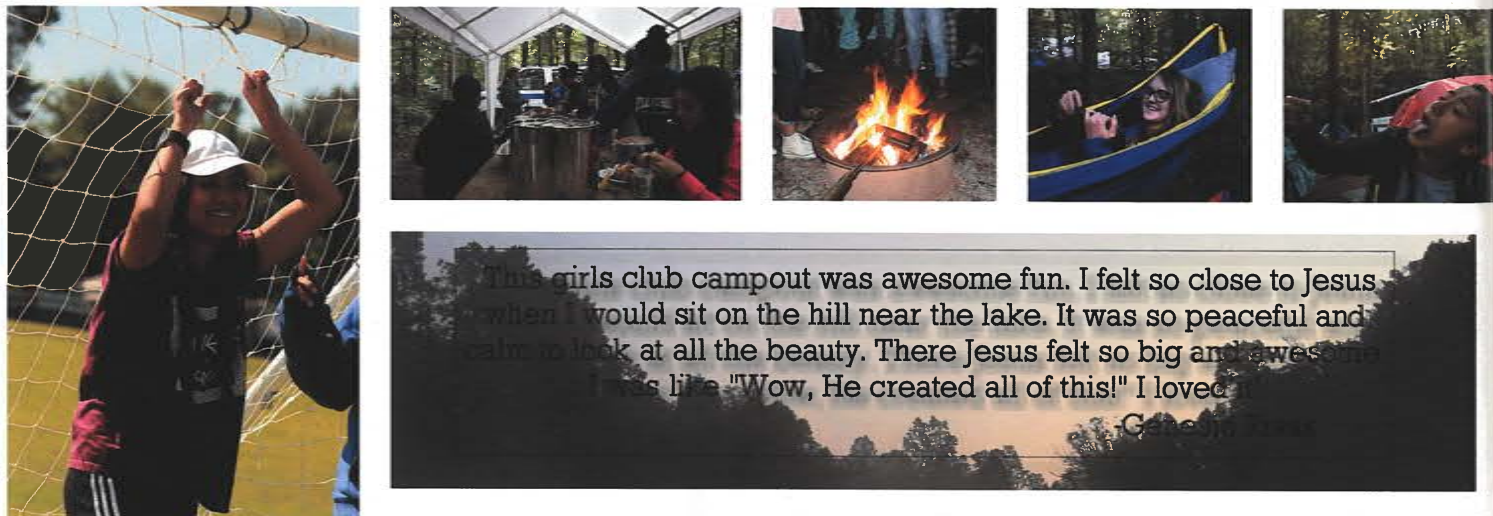

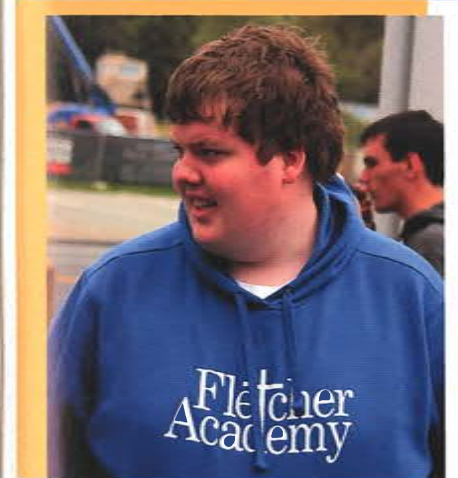
A Splash of History

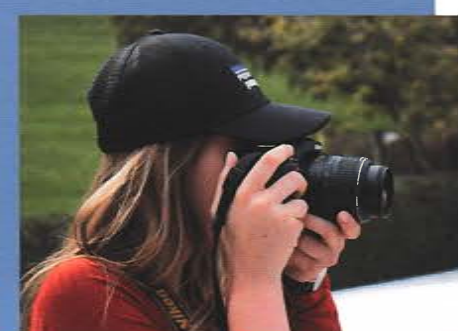

Hanging with Nature

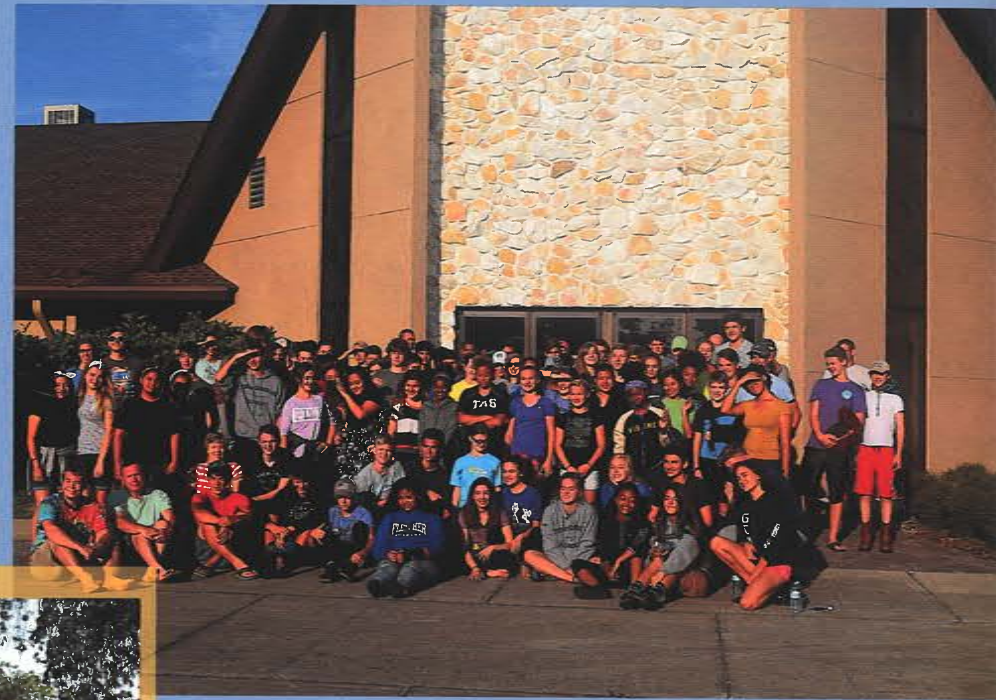

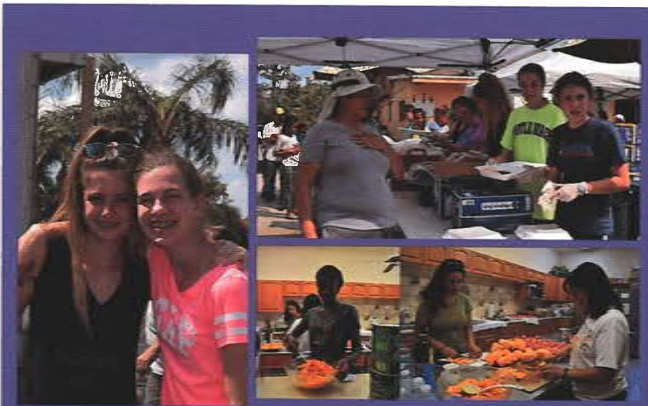

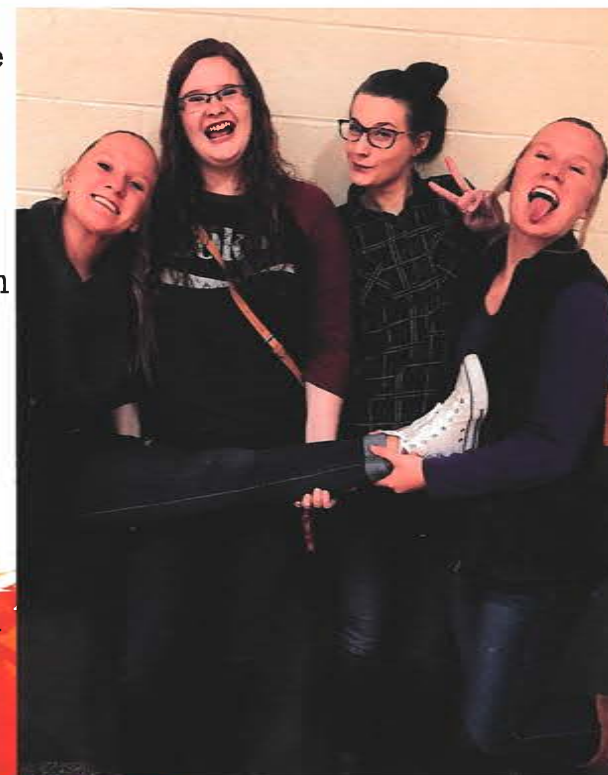
FOOD AND FLANNEL

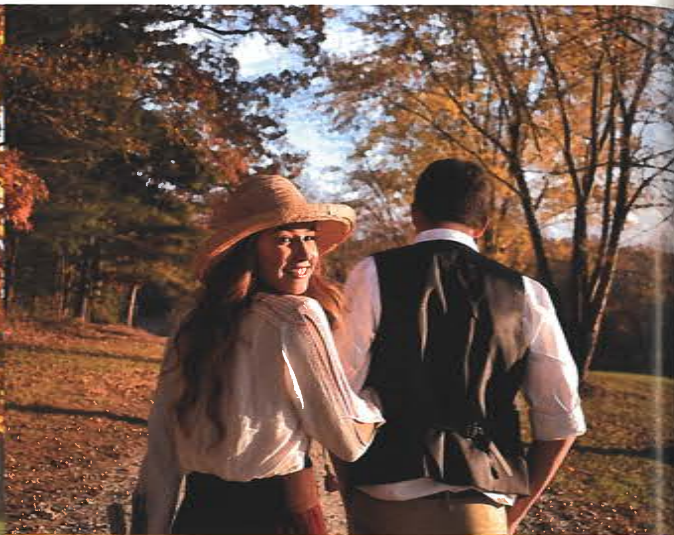

LET Christmas BEGIN

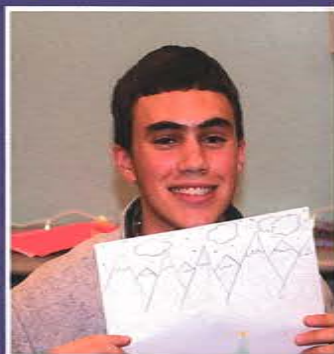

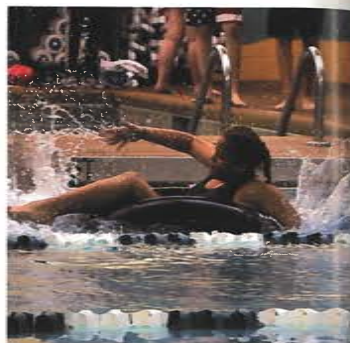
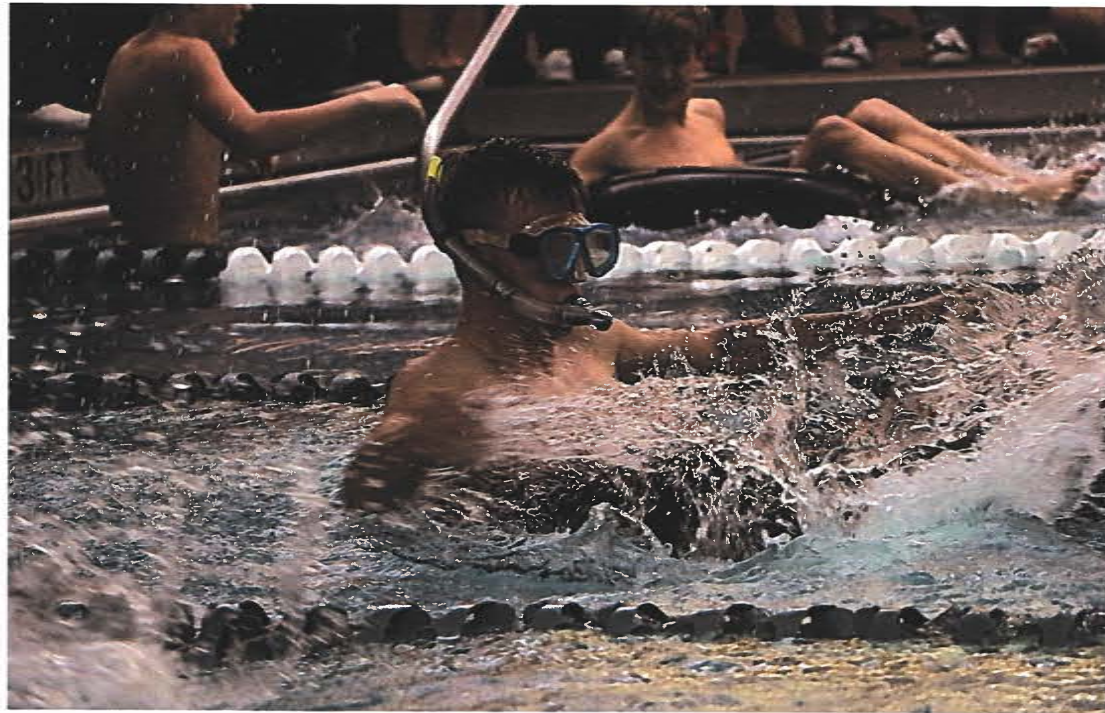
Splashin' Activities

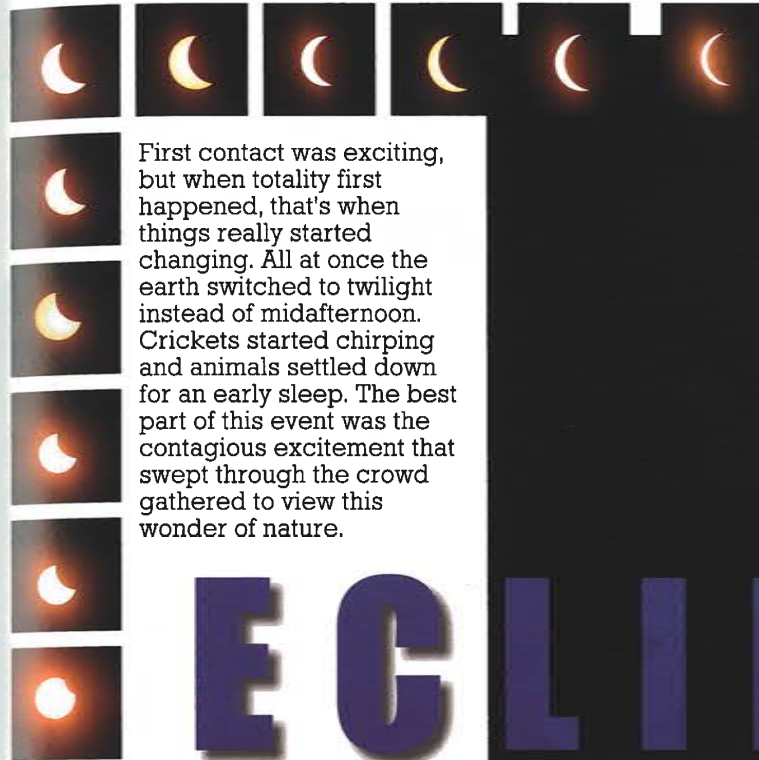


WORTH THE WAIT

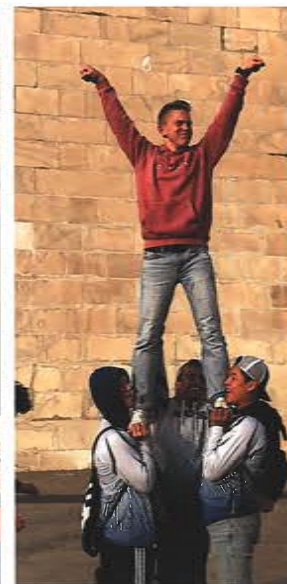
ACRO STRONG

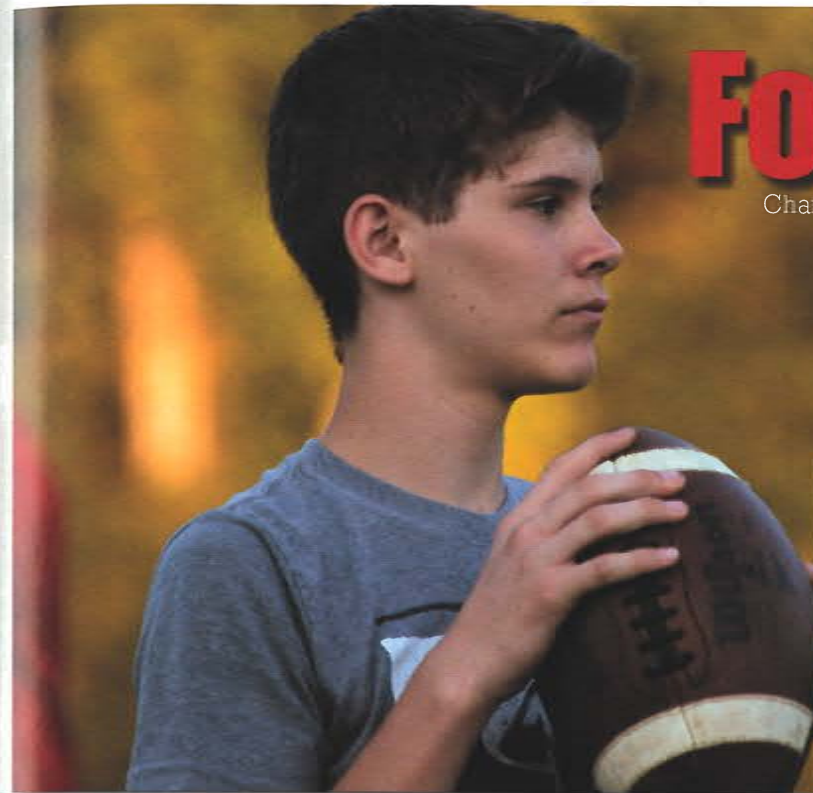
BONDS THAT LAST A LIFETIME

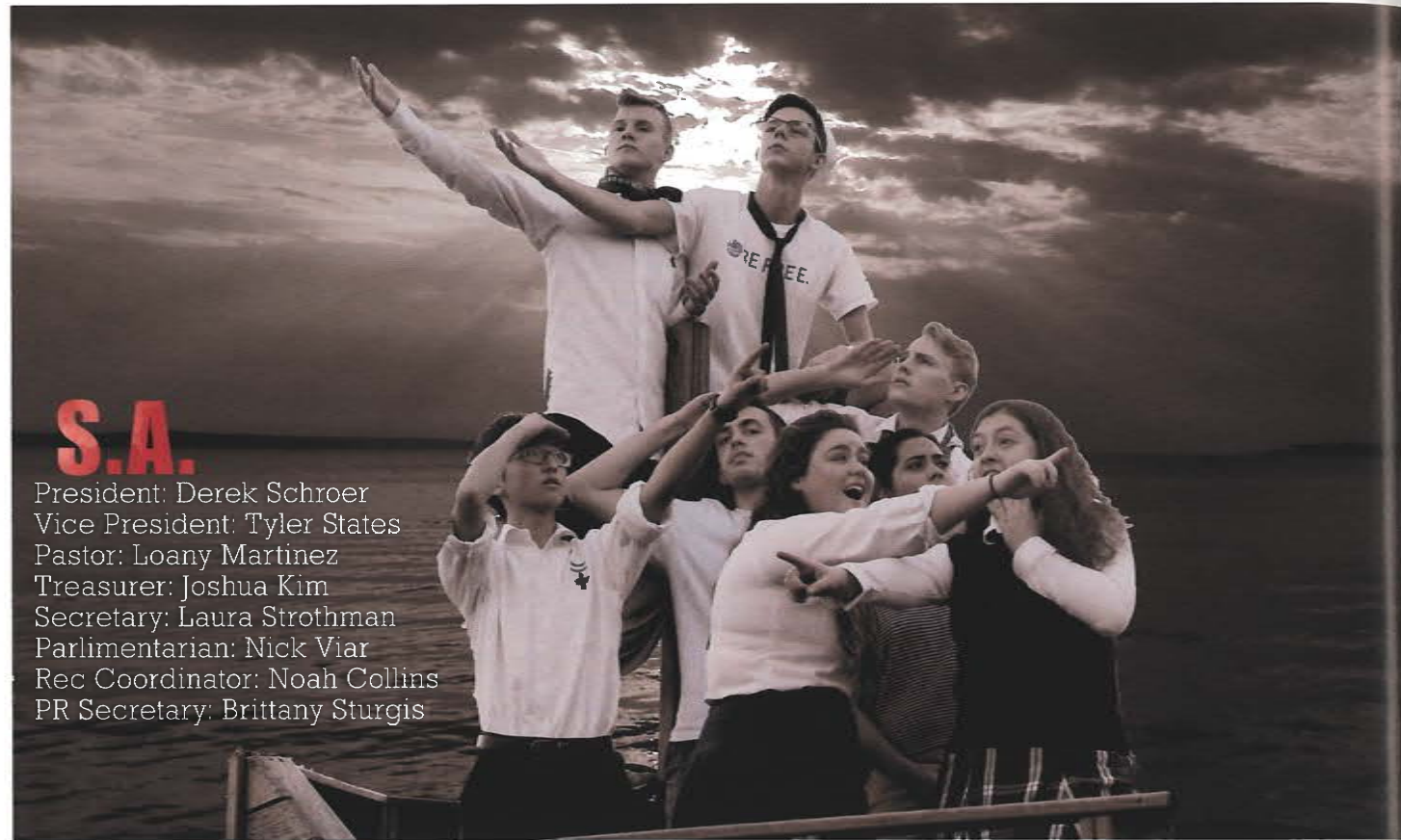


BOYS DORM

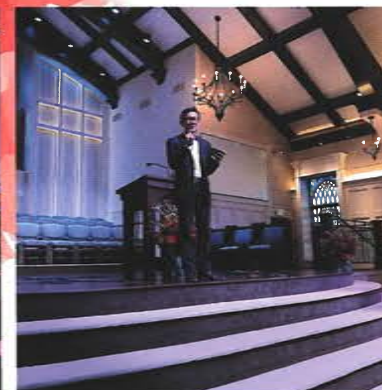


WINTER FUNDAY

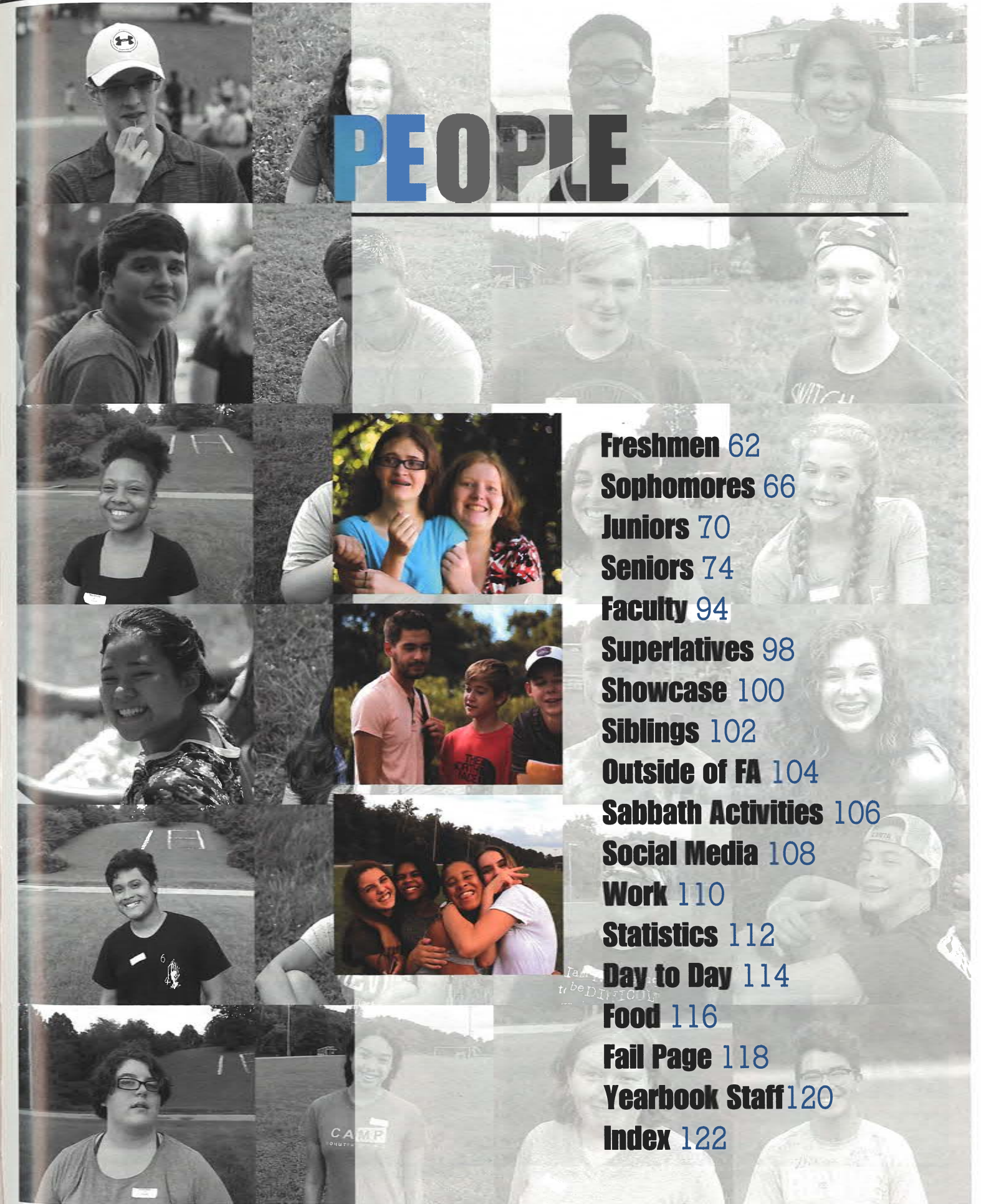


WEEK OF PRAYER
